The home standing Eagles wasted no time in taking the lead in this game by plating three runs in the bottom of the second with Christian Del Bosque leading off the frame with a walk, courtesy runner Kristian Barcena promptly stole second, David Lopez was hit by a pitch Barcena and Lopez advanced to third and second respectively courtesy of a wild pitch, with two outs Isaac Gonzalez stroked a two RBI single to drive in Kristian Barcena and David Lopez with Isaac Gonzalez taking second on an error, Rey Rey Mendoza brought Isaac Gonzalez with an RBI single to give the Eagles the early 3 to 0 lead.

The Eagles extended their lead with another three run output. The Eagles then closed out the scoring with a lone run in the bottom of the fifth with pinch hitter CJ Jimenez leading off the frame with a single, Isaac Gonzalez also singled, Rey Rey Mendoza was hit by a pitch to load the bases, Dee Andre Torres drew a bases loaded walk to bring home CJ Jimenez with the 8th and final run of this game with the proud Eagle Pass Eagles taking the 9 to 1 victory over the South San Bobcats.
